

SENIOR PATROL LEADER

1. Assign troop leadership positions:
 - Learn what Troop members and other leaders can do.
 - Appoint Assistant Senior Patrol Leader who will function as SPL in my absence.
 - Appoint qualified Scouts to Troop positions of Scribe, Historian, Librarian and Quartermaster, Instructor, Bugler and Chaplain Aide with the advice and consent of the Scoutmaster and his staff.
 - Assign duties and responsibilities to other leaders as needed.
2. Work with the Scoutmaster in training and providing direct leadership to Troop Guides, Patrol Leaders and the ASPL.
3. Preside at all troop meetings, events, activities and annual planning conference.
4. Plan and lead monthly PLC meetings. Develop Troop spirit.
5. Ensure that the Troop membership rules are fairly and consistently administered. Handle minor discipline problems as outlined in the Troop membership Rules.
6. Work on my advancement.
7. Set a good example, especially in behavior, attendance and leadership. Attend at least 75% of all meetings and 50% of all campouts during my term of office.
8. Enthusiastically wear the uniform correctly as instructed.
9. Live by the Scout Oath and Law.

As Senior Patrol Leader, I promise to do my best to fulfill the requirements of this position throughout the coming period. I understand that my performance in this position will be evaluated by the Scoutmaster and the adult leaders on the basis of my abilities and the job description given above, as -well as the demonstration of Scout Spirit and leadership at Troop meetings and other events.
